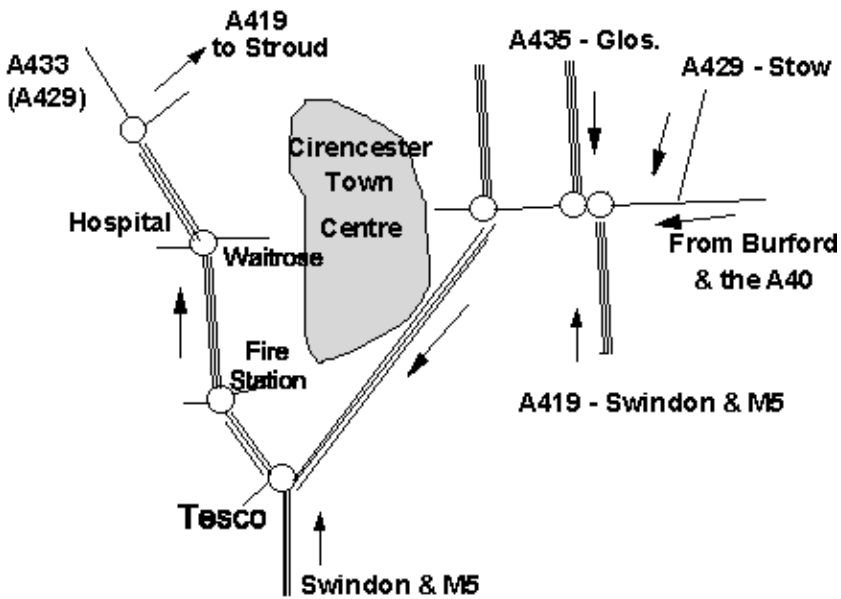


## Route to Amberley Church

Leave M4 at J15 - A435/A419. Follow A419 north towards Cirencester.  
(OR approach Cirencester from some other direction – see map!)



If you are coming up the A419 from Swindon, there are 2 exits for Cirencester from the bypass. The first one (which mentions the Industrial Area) will bring you up to the Tesco roundabout above, and the second one (which mentions Stow) will bring you in from the east of the town as shown. If you don't know Ciren, it's mildly easier to use the first.

At Cirencester, use the map above to find your way around the ring road and at the last roundabout (see above), turn right for Stroud and Minchinhampton A419.

After about 5 miles, you will pass the White Horse Garage and pub on your left. About half a mile later, you will pass an old airfield on your left. Immediately after this, take the left turn signposted Minchinhampton.

Follow this road and after about 3 or 4 miles, you will emerge into the wide-open spaces of Minchinhampton Common (mind the cows!). Follow the road over the Common. In the middle of the common, you will find a crossroads – This is Tom Longs Post. Turn left here and IMMEDIATELY right, signposted Amberley. After about ½ a mile, the road bends right and starts to descend off the common. Take the first turning on your left, in front of the school and you will find the church about 300 yds along here.
